



Followspots are arguably the most important fixtures of any lighting rig, ensuring the performers on stage are always illuminated and never stray from the limelight.

Conventional followspots have been a staple component of theatre productions for over a hundred years, but rapid improvements in tracking technology have pushed remote followspot systems into contention.

Could a remote followspot system satisfy the challenges facing the Tivoli Theatre, a much-loved local theatre in Wimborne?

Are they just a gimmick or the new era of followspotting?


THE CHALLENGE

A recent health and safety audit at the Tivoli Theatre identified a requirement to move the followspots from their current positions to create extra space in the fire escape routes.

This, in addition to aging equipment and the ongoing challenges of sourcing experienced crew, led Production Manager Kyle Best to contact Stage Electrics and discuss which upgrade options were best suited to their venue.

As a local theatre which welcomes many touring shows, Kyle needed to find a solution which could be easily adopted by their own productions as well as the many touring shows hosted at the Tivoli. One which provided value for money and affords Lighting Designers a broad palette of creative options.





THE SOLUTION

Stage Electrics visited the Tivoli Theatre and presented a range of followspot upgrade options. Whilst replacing the current system with newer, more compact followspots would have alleviated some of their problems, others would have remained.

zactrack Mini, a remote followspot system trusted by hundreds of venues around the world, quickly emerged as the preferred solution. In partnership with Ambersphere Solutions, zactrack's UK distributor, we organised a demonstration of the zactrack Mini system, utilising the Tivoli's lighting rig and control console. It was clear to see: a remote followspot system was the ideal solution for the Tivoli, solving their problems with numerous additional benefits.

The zactrack Mini system installed at the Tivoli uses six anchor points which detect the location of up to five trackers worn by performers on stage.

The anchors, positioned on the front truss, in the wings and on stage create a 3D map of where the performers are.

zactrack takes a DMX signal from the master anchor and feeds it into the lighting control console, which tells the lights allocated as followspots what to do. One significant benefit of zactrack over conventional followspots is that multiple lights can be assigned to track a single performer.

Customisable settings such as beam size, colour, focus and frost are all easily adjustable through the lighting console. A useful feature of zactrack is that when a performer leaves the stage, the lights following them automatically fade down. When they reappear on stage, the lights reposition themselves, before fading the followspot light back up.

Stage Electrics supplied four Ayrton Diablo Si moving lights, also distributed in the UK by Ambersphere Solutions, which were integrated into the lighting rig and help with followspot duties.



THE RESULT

zactrack has ushered in a new era of versatility and efficiency for the Tivoli Theatre. The system has enabled shows at the Tivoli to be produced more costeffectively with greater creative freedom than ever before.

Once limited to tracking one or two performers on stage, zactrack Mini enables lighting designers to follow up to five performers at any one time, using fixtures already in the lighting rig. No auditorium seats are lost to accommodate followspots and technical crew are free to perform other duties during the show.

The Tivoli technical staff and touring crew who've produced shows in the venue all agree: zactrack is a revolutionary tool in the followspotting arsenal.
