

AV, LIGHTING & PRODUCTION SYSTEMS DESIGN AND INSTALLATION



We saved them 30% off the cost advice they had originally received. Crucially, this 30% saving brought the project within budget.

THE CHALLENGE

ICC Wales was announced to the public in 2013, pitched as one of the UK's most technologically advanced and sustainable convention centres. The objective was to create a light and spacious venue where technology makes life simpler.

Stage Electrics were invited to join the project early, initially to advise on lighting systems. As we brought greater insight and expertise, we were elevated to the level of artisan contractor, reporting directly to the client, with greater responsibility for specification and budgetary control.

The brief was simple: to design a technical systems infrastructure which pushed ICC Wales to the forefront of innovation, whilst ensuring the project was environmentally and budget conscious.



THE SOLUTION

Stage Electrics provided a full-service solution, involving the design, specification, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of AV, production lighting and sound systems. This included all the cabling, facility panels and racks.

Our engineers, designers and integration specialists worked alongside the wider design team to define the building's technical specification. This was a collaborative process, with us advising on the most energy and cost-efficient installation.


Reducing complexity and improving efficiency, we combined the high-quality background music and performance paging system with the Public Address Voice Alarm (PAVA) system. Integrating the two into one provided added flexibility within a single user interface and significantly reduced


costs compared to installing two separate systems.

By specifying LED lighting throughout the venue, we not only reduced power consumption, but also the amount of wiring needed. This had a double benefit: reducing costs and the carbon impact of the building.

A networked smart technology system enables one member of staff to operate all the venue lighting from an iPad, with local control available in each room if required. Using the technical infrastructure at ICC Wales couldn't be simpler or more efficient.

Onsite, we managed the installation and commissioning of AV, stage lighting and stage engineering systems. With one eye on efficiency, we outsourced approved contactors to carry out non-specialist tasks, enabling our own engineers to focus on other key considerations including controlling costs.





We specified and supplied a broad range of products for installation in ICC Wales.

Rigging and drapes from Prolyte and Admiral Staging. Lighting equipment from ETC, Chauvet, Avolites and Robert Juliat. Audio products from RCF, Yamaha, D&B Audiotechnik, and Shure. Video and projection systems from Panasonic, Black Magic and Roland.

Our Manufacturing department built audiovisual facility panels, equipment racks, custom cables, and internally wired lighting bars used throughout the venue.

All products we supplied were installed, tested, and commissioned by our specialist engineers.

At the height of the project, in Summer 2019, there were around 20 Stage Electrics Engineers, Project Managers and specialists on site. An additional 20 staff back in our Bristol facility were dedicated to building racks and panels, testing equipment before it shipped to site and dealing with the day-to-day logistics of working on an £85 million project.

THE RESULT

Stage Electrics satisfied all the requirements for Russell Phillips and his team at ICC Wales. We provided systems which contributed to the award-winning venue, is cheaper to operate than their competitors and saved them 30% off their original cost advice.

The reduced operating costs of ICC Wales have been the decisive factor in attracting key events. A full conference and exhibition for ICC Wales's capacity might typically require around 15 full time technical staff at most other venues, whereas ICC Wales requires only six.

Although many changes occurred throughout the project, Stage Electrics were the only company trusted and valued enough to remain from the initial design stages throughout the project to handover and beyond.

We even supported the venue with the recruitment and on-boarding of key appointments, for both construction and post-completion operational staff.

The work done by Stage Electrics has been widely respected across the events industry, with ICC Wales being awarded the accolade for 'Best Tech Forward Venue' at the 2021 M&IT Awards.

As ICC Wales's reputation blooms, and event organisers continue to talk positively about their experiences, ICC Wales will go on to become one of the UK's premier conference centres.
